Learn to Swim Program

Swimming lessons for ages two and up are offered with a choice of three classes of instruction:

- 1. Typical Class— 3-5 students per instructor
- 2. Special Class—2 students per instructor
- 3. Private Class—1 student per instructor

Instruction

A typical class will have three to five students to each instructor. Lessons will be scheduled at half hour intervals from 9 a.m. to Noon, Monday through Friday. Special classes will have one instructor for every two students, for those who need extra attention. Private classes are guaranteed a one-to-one instructor-tochild ratio at all times. Your child will get the personal attention needed to learn the basics of swimming.
