

On July 1, 1992, the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act went into effect requiring institutions receiving federal student aid funds to make available to prospective students information regarding graduation, retention, and attrition rates beginning in July of 1993. Successful outcomes of students' academic performance are measured by graduates, transfers, persisters, and those receiving a Certificate.

Of the 1,000 associate-level students who entered Alfred State College in the fall of 2005, 417 (41.70%) graduated within three years; 323 (32.30%) graduated within two years; 203 (20.30%) transferred to another SUNY institution without a degree; 56 (5.00%) transferred to a non-SUNY institution without a degree; 64 (6.40%) were still enrolled in the fall of 2008; and three students (0.30%) received a certificate.

In summary, 743 of the 1,000 students (74.3%) who enrolled at Alfred State College in the fall of 2005 achieved a successful outcome. Alfred State College has the highest on-time graduation rate of all SUNY Colleges of Technology.
