## Day Camp Program

The camp includes a totally supervised program of daily instruction in a variety of sports, arts and crafts, and recreational activities, in addition to a daily free swim period each afternoon.

Highlights include basic instruction in tennis and softball, soccer games, and a variety of arts and crafts activities. The day camp includes a choice of three plans:

## Learn to Swim Program

Swimming lessons for ages two and up are offered with a choice of three classes of instruction:

1. Typical Class— 3-5 students per instructor
2. Special Class—2 students per instructor
3. Private Class—1 student per instructor

- B. Primary Skills
- C. Stroke Readiness
- D. Stroke Development

## Instruction

A typical class will have three to five students to each instructor. Lessons will be scheduled at half hour intervals from 9 a.m. to Noon, Monday through Friday. Special classes will have one instructor for every two students, for those who need extra attention. Private classes are guaranteed a one-to-one instructor-to-child ratio at all times. Your child will get the personal attention needed to learn the basics of swimming.
