Romanesque:

Any building – *Do Not Do: Leaning Tower of Pisa, Stave churches, Norway – too small.*

Gothic:

Almost any building but *Do Not Do: Notre Dame, Paris; Notre Dame, Chartres (can do other Notre Dames); Cathedral, Milan*

Asian, Chinese, Japanese:

This is a tough – most bldgs. have no interior rooms or if they do, there are no floor plans or rooms are tiny or floor plans are hard to find. Search other library resources if you like this style. Could do Horyuji Temple complex.

Islamic:

Almost any building but *Do Not Do: Dome of the Rock (great building – too small); Taj Mahal; The Alhambra.*

Les Invalides, Paris (not the hospital)
