NOTE:

*Entry level of student into Math and Composition/Literature sequences is a function of a student's high school preparation and Mathematics and English placement examinations.

**Students recommended for COMP 1403 – English Fundamentals must take ASDC 2193 – Intro to Academic Literacy.

Students that start at a lower level of Math and/or English than what is identified in the typical four-semester program must be aware that it may **extend** their program from two to three years.
