



HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR PROGRAM INTERVIEW



Program specific interviews and the questions asked, are meant to provide a way for faculty to assess the applicant in the following areas:

- Knowledge of the profession:
 - ▶ Radiologic Technology
 - ▶ Diagnostic Medical Sonography
- Knowledge of the program.
- Have you completed any job shadowing? If so, share your experiences.
- Motivation/determination.
- Professionalism.
- Academic abilities.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Be sure to do your research.
 - ▶ Know about the program and school.
 - ▶ Know about the profession and what you will be doing after graduation.
- Speak clearly and confidently.
- Be honest.
- Avoid "expected" answers.
- Practice your interviewing skills with a friend beforehand.
- Relax and ask questions!

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Find a quiet spot where you can hear and be heard with minimal distractions.
- Make sure you can access the meeting link (if virtual).
- Turn on your camera.
- Dress your best!
- Be on time!
