Alfred State College continues to reign as a top choice for prospective students, including the No. 1 ranking among SUNY regional colleges. The 2023 *US News & World Report* Best Colleges list of northern regional colleges also shows ASC at No. 6 among Top Public Schools. When compared to all public and private colleges in the 11-state northern region, Alfred State is No. 9.

NOTES FROM ADMISSIONS

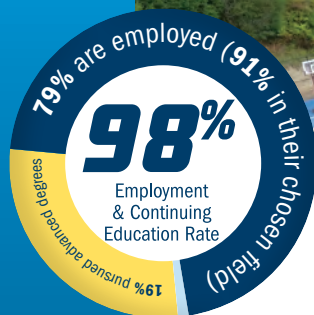
Alfred State continues to be test optional for the spring 2023, fall 2023, and spring 2024 semesters; highest reading/writing and math scores will be used if multiple scores provided; the ACT is not superscored.

With the addition of **dedicated portals**, the enrollment process has become more efficient for students this past year. From the point of application, students will have access to personalized portals where they can easily locate their application status and decision information. Once accepted the portal navigates the student through important enrollment steps including, submitting the deposit; applying for financial aid; signing up for housing; orientation; submitting health information; and paying their bill among other things.

To ensure that students have exposure to the medical imaging sciences field, **diagnostic medical sonography** and **radiologic technology** applicants must complete an interview with the Department Chair prior to acceptance.

Several of Alfred State's programs continue to be popular, and an early application is recommended. These include diagnostic medical sonography; electrical construction and maintenance electrician; heating, ventilation, and air conditioning; heavy equipment truck and diesel technician; heavy equipment operations; radiologic technology; and welding technology.



ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

The Forensic Science Education Accreditation Commission (FEPAC) has granted the Alfred State College (ASC) forensic science technology program a second 5-year full accreditation. In addition, the **forensic science technology** program has a new affiliation in place with LECOM (Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine). Their early acceptance program allows for students in high school to apply to both Alfred State's forensic science technology program and to LECOM's College of Osteopathic Medicine or its College of Pharmacy.

Alfred State College (ASC) received a two-year multi-campus grant with the University of Buffalo's School of Nursing to increase enrollment and address emerging trends in nursing education, eventually increasing medical services in underserved populations. The \$250,000 grant from SUNY High Needs Nursing Program was awarded to Alfred State and UB. The money supports such efforts as a program liaison to coordinate activities between campuses, workshops and training events, and telehealth-related equipment and enhancements. As part of the collaboration, **Alfred State BS prepared nurses can enroll in the University of Buffalo's online Adult Geriatric DNP program.**

Health Information Technology graduates had a 100% pass rate on the RHIT exam for first-time test takers in 2021.

Digital Media and Animation has a new Motion Capture Studio. We are excited about this new opportunity for our students to animate characters of their own design using live motion. Motion capture technology is an industry standard for animated movement, especially in the game design and 3D animation industries. A motion capture suit is used to create original movement for use in animation. Students learn how to capture, export and apply motion capture data in their projects. Nearly all 3D animated movies use motion capture as their primary source of movement. It is essential that animators understand how to create, use and manipulate motion capture data.

New Academic Program: Civil Engineering Technology (BS)

Available fall 2023 for students entering their first year, civil engineering technology (BS) graduates will be prepared to assist in the design, specification, testing, analysis and construction of built systems and infrastructure. Specific focus areas of the program include the design and construction of roads, subdivisions, water and wastewater systems, and related industries. The broad education provided by this curriculum will provide a foundation that contributes to the design and construction of sustainable communities.



CAMPUS LIFE

The **Pioneer Student Center** is finalizing renovations and will include a studio hosting yoga, zumba, fencing and karate classes among others. There is a new GamesNation suite called The Underground that supports console based gaming and other events like comedians and trivia night. There is a Barbershop located on the ground floor that will allow local barbers to come to campus and provide haircuts for students. The Feast Beast, located in the parking lot, will offer another evening food option for students.

Three New Varsity Sports

"We are thrilled to announce the additions of women's lacrosse, women's wrestling, and the reinstatement of men's lacrosse to our department," said Director of Athletics Jason Doviak.

"The balanced number of sport offerings align well with our strategic efforts to provide even more females the opportunity to compete on our campus and support the growth within the AMCC Conference."

Women's wrestling will start in the 2023-24 school year while both lacrosse programs will begin action in the 2024-2025 school year.

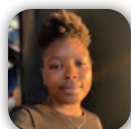

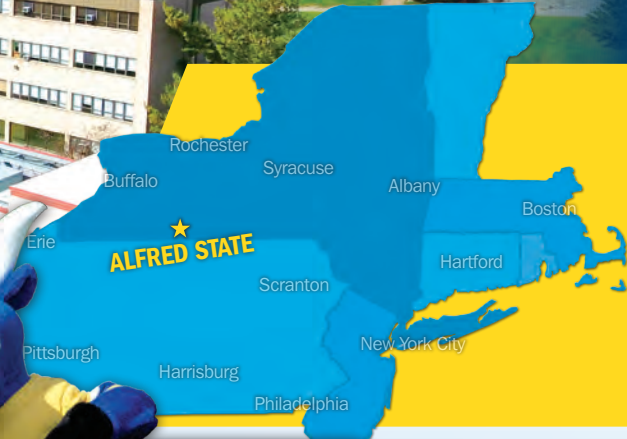
