



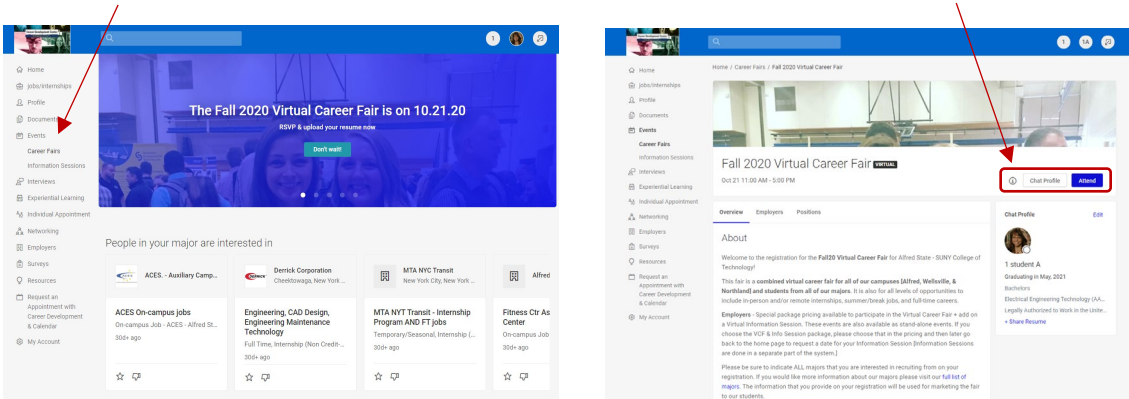
Career Development ToGo – Digital Packs [VCF]

This ToGo pack includes a variety of resources to help you prepare for and navigate **Virtual Career Fairs**.

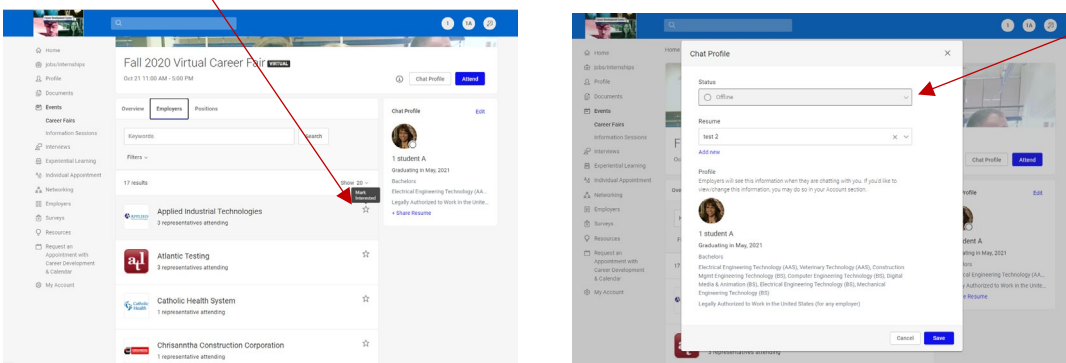

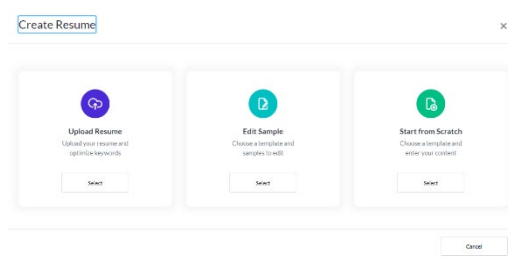
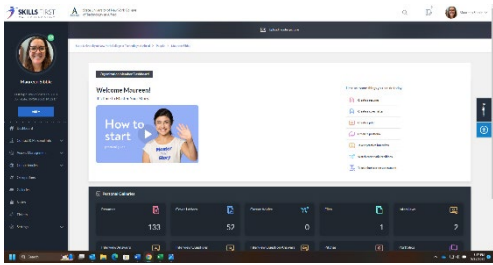
To start preparing for the Alfred State VCF, you will need create/login to your [JobLink](#) account and go to **Events – Career Fairs** and click **Attend**. Here you can upload your résumé and then begin researching companies that you would like to connect with. Check to see if they have current postings and if they will be hosting an Information Session. RSVP for Information Session right in the Events section – **Information Session** tab. Also be sure to complete your **Chat Profile** before the day of the fair!



Click on the **Employers** tab to view the registrations [note – new registrations come in daily until the day of the fair]. Click the stars for the employers you are interested in. When the fair is active, the link to join the chat queue will be found here too. You can always edit your **Chat Profile**. On the day of the VCF, you will change your status to **Online**.
