NOTES FROM ADMISSIONS

Several of Alfred State's programs continue to be popular, and an early application is recommended. These include electrical construction and maintenance electrician; heating, ventilation, and air conditioning; heavy equipment truck and diesel technician; heavy equipment operations; and welding technology.

Students applying for **radiologic technology and diagnostic medical sonography** are encouraged to apply prior to Dec. 1 in order to be included in the priority review process. Qualified applicants who meet the academic criteria will be invited to participate in an interview with the selection committee and will be notified of their decision by mid-January with an enrollment deposit deadline of March 1. Completed applications received after Dec. 1 will be included in the traditional rolling admissions process. Job shadowing is strongly encouraged.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

For the third year in a row, Alfred State placed first in the design-build division in the Associated Schools of **Construction Region 1 Student Competition** held in Albany. The college also had a strong showing in the commercial division.

The **nursing** program celebrated an 88.37% NCLEX pass rate this year for first-time test takers.

Students in the upper-level **Kinesiology** course are using programs with Virtual Reality (VR) to dissect and view the movement of joints in action. This gives them a better understanding of the human body and its movements, preparing them for further education and careers in the health professions.

Our **Culinary Arts Department** offers a new hands-on learning lab at **The Collegiate Restaurant** on Main Street in Alfred. The lab will offer real world experience in menu planning and preparation of short order restaurant items.

A group of senior **engineering** students designed a Marble Run Machine that is now displayed in the Student Leadership Center. If you visit the Admissions Office on campus, be sure to check this out in person!



Digital Media and Animation students are using new motion capture suits for project creation. The department also offers the opportunity to study abroad in Tokyo, Japan. The three-week trips allow students to tour various spots in the animation industry and work with local artists on an animated piece. Highlights include Studio Ghibli and The Gundam Museum.



NEW ACADEMICS

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Animal Care Assistant: Provides hands-on experience and foundational skills for employment or continued education in veterinary and animal care-related fields. Ideal for students preparing for Alfred State's veterinary technology AAS program.

Practical Nursing: This program prepares students to work under the supervision of other health care professionals as a licensed practical nurse (LPN). Upon completion, students are eligible to apply for licensure in New York as an LPN and sit for the NCLEX-PN exam to launch a nursing career.

Voice Writing (Online): This program trains students in the specialized skill of verbatim reporting. Coursework covers voice speed control, transcription software, reporting techniques, and legal documentation procedures, preparing graduates to produce transcripts across diverse legal settings.

MICROCREDENTIAL

Certified Personal Trainer: Prepares students for a career or side business in personal training by providing the knowledge and skills necessary to obtain certification through the International Sports Sciences Association (ISSA). Upon passing the ISSA Certified Personal Trainer exam in the first course, students will have the opportunity to gain hands-on experience by working with volunteer clients in a training capacity.



CAMPUS LIFE

Students are enjoying our newest clubs: golf, volleyball, and badminton.

Recreation is now offering fitness classes, Yoga, Pilates, and REFIT, Monday through Thursday evenings.

New Living and Learning Communities (LLC)

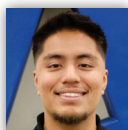

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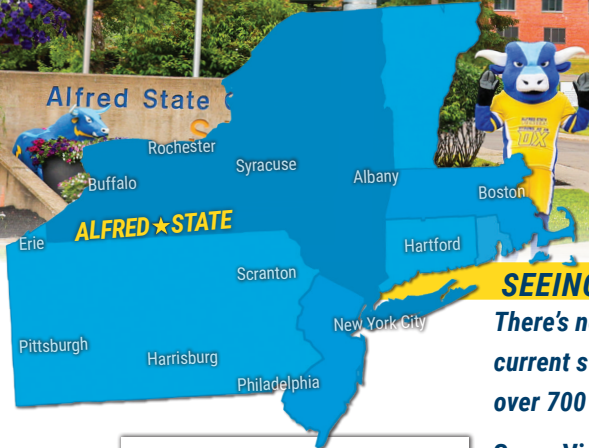
