INFORMATION

If you elect to file a report with law enforcement, any potential criminal activity related to the incident you reported may be investigated. You may also choose to consult a private attorney to explore legal options.

If you elect <u>not</u> to pursue or participate in disciplinary action (as applicable) with the Title IX and/or Student Conduct Office, the College may determine it is necessary to pursue the complaint process without your involvement. You will be notified if such an action is needed. In addition, the College may be required to document this report for Clery Act statistics. The Clery Act requires all colleges and universities that participate in federal financial aid programs to keep and disclose information about crime on and near their respective campuses. No personally identifiable information about you is disclosed in the preparation and publishing of Clery Act reports.

The College can act on your complaint if you decide to pursue it later. You may request further action at any future time, consistent with the institution's policy. However, the longer the period lapsed from the time of the incident, the more difficult it will be to obtain information.

You may have protections under Title IX and the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)/Clery Act. Sexual harassment, assault, and violence are forms of sex discrimination and therefore violate law and policy. Retaliation against anyone who participates in a complaint process will result in appropriate sanctions or other disciplinary action as covered by applicable policies, laws and/or collective bargaining agreements.

You are encouraged to meet with the Title IX Coordinator at any time to discuss your options, concerns and questions.
